

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (FOUNDRY LANE SAFER ROUTES TO SCHOOL) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effect of which would be to introduce:

1. No waiting at any time restrictions in the following locations:
 - a. **Amphill Road**, *both sides*, From its junction with Foundry Lane westwards for 10m.
 - b. **English Road**, *north side*, From 10m west of its junction with Foundry Lane westwards for 10m; From 10m east of its junction with Imperial Avenue to 24m west of its junction with Imperial Avenue, *south side*, From 19m west of its junction with Foundry Lane westwards for 6m (In place of existing H-bar marking), From 20m east of its junction with Imperial Avenue to 10m west of its junction with Imperial Avenue.
 - c. **Foundry Lane**, *west side*, From 10m south of its junction with Amphill Road to 10m north of its junction with Amphill Road; From 10m south of its junction with Kingsley Road to 10m north of its junction with Kingsley Road; From 15m north of its junction with English Road northwards to the extended boundary between 233 and 235 Foundry Lane, *east side*, From 15m north of its junction with Heysham Road to 3m north of the boundary between 229 and 231 Foundry Lane.
 - d. **Imperial Avenue**, *both sides*, From 10m south of its junction with English Road northwards to 10m north of its junction with English Road.
 - e. **Kingsley Road**, *both sides*, From its junction with Foundry Lane westwards for 10m.
