

The City of Southampton (Static Restrictions) (West) (Amendment 10) Order 2026

Statement of Reasons

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising (*i.e. to improve safety*)
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

As part of the redevelopment of the Outdoor Sports Centre a new car park is being constructed along with an improved access from Dunkirk Road which is being provided as part of a Section 278 agreement. In order to support access to and from this new car park, additional no waiting at any time restrictions are being proposed to prevent obstructive and potentially unsafe parking in the immediate vicinity.

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
