Lordswood Road Pedestrian Crossing Improvements: Monday 15 June 2026

Balfour Beatty is working in partnership with Southampton City Council to manage the highways service across Southampton. As part of the sports centre project that has been ongoing, we will be carrying out pedestrian-priority carriageway works to improve road safety, ensuring the community can travel around the city more confidently whatever their mode of transport.

We are writing to update you on a change of date for the upcoming works along Lordswood Road with the installation of a pedestrian crossing.

Southern Gas Network have reduced their scope of works, resulting in the traffic management on Lordswood Road being removed early. Originally the work to install the new pedestrian crossing on Lordswood Road and works by SCC's Tree Team were scheduled to occur collaboratively with the gas works, however, as there has been a change in the programme, these works will start from **Monday 15 June** until **Friday 10 July 2026 including weekends**.

To ensure a safe working environment we will be installing traffic management, closing Lordswood Road westbound from Coxford Road to during the works, the traffic management will be installed overnight on **Sunday 14 June 2026**.

Finally whilst the road closure is in place, we will also be undertaking drainage works and Road resurfacing, due to access requirements to the drains we will need to place a **3-night full road closure** on **Wednesday 8 July 2026** through to **Friday 10 July 2026, from the junction of Coxford Road and Lordswood Road through to the junction of Lordswood Road and Hill Lane** these nightly road closures will be **from 8:00pm-6:00am**.

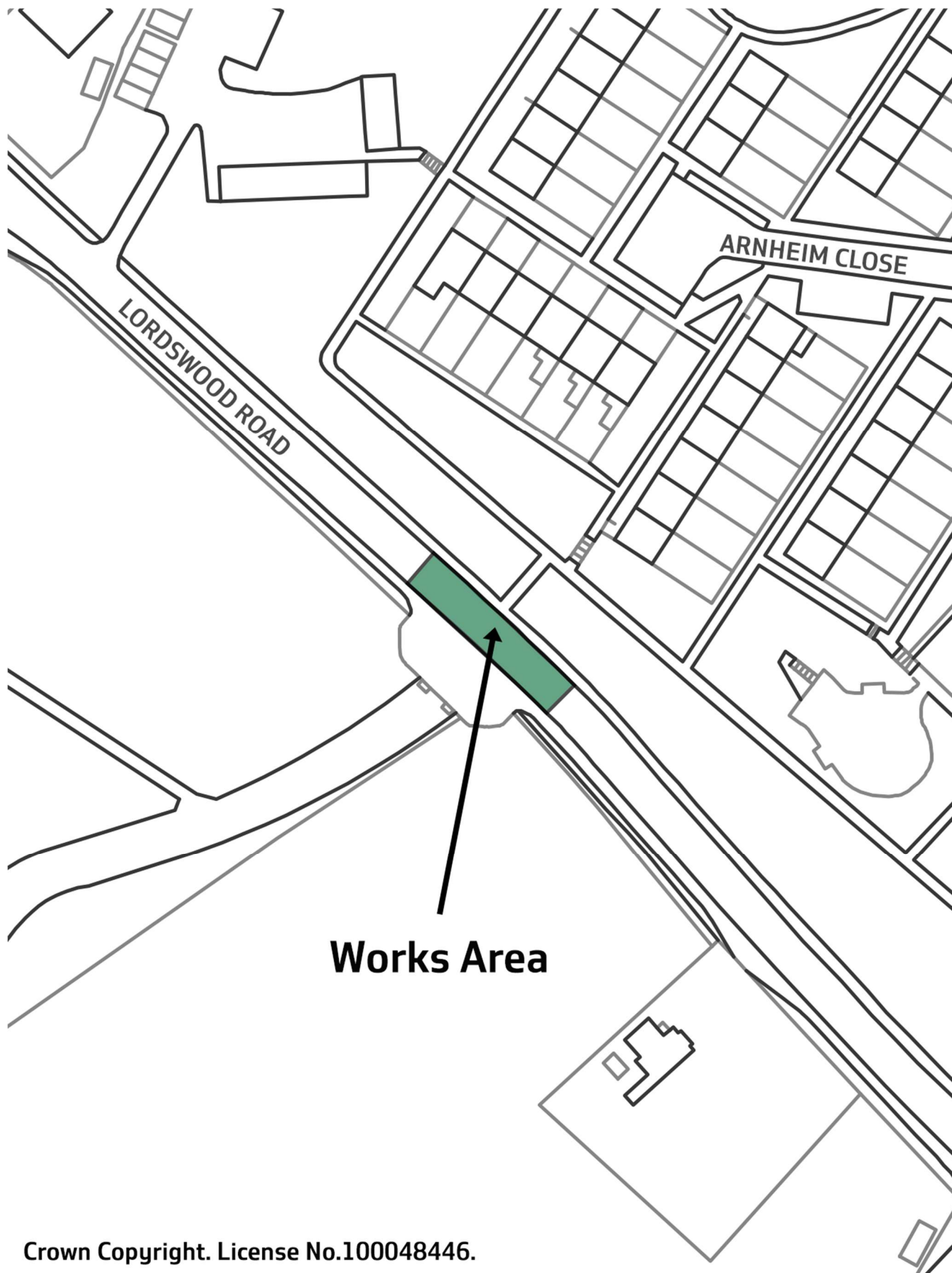
Access for residents of Lordswood Road and Lordswood Close will be maintained, via the gate person who will be on duty at either end of the closure points. Please note, it will not be possible to travel through the road as there will be apparatus across the road at the junction of **Dunkirk and Dale Valley Road**.

The dates in this letter are subject to change, dependant on favourable weather conditions. In the event that works are delayed or ahead of schedule, we will alert you of any changes to the construction dates using yellow 'advance warning' signs in the area.

Properties close to the works area may experience a temporary disturbance such as flashing lights and reversing sirens, as this can be a noisy process. We would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience or disruption this work may cause.
