

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (STATIC RESTRICTIONS) (WEST) (AMENDMENT 9) ORDER 2026

### Statement of Reasons

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

The Council received a resident request, supported by ward Councillors, to amend the current permit parking arrangement in zone 16, specifically Anglesea Road, Medina Road, Sandown Road and Sydney Road.

An informal survey was undertaken and the results showed support to make the following changes, namely:

1. Changing the bays on Sandown Road to permit holders only, to reflect the high level of support from this road for the change.
2. Retaining the 2-hour limited waiting provision for the remaining roads but changing the no return period from 2 hours to no return within the same day. While it is noted that residents of Anglesea Road and Medina Road were not overall in favour of any changes, it is considered beneficial for the no return period to be consistent within the area. The change will also support effective enforcement and therefore encourage a turnover of vehicles for the benefit of eligible residents as a whole.

As such the Council is now formally proposing the Traffic Regulation Order required to introduce the scheme.

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s122 subsection (2) of that Act).
