St Monica Safer Routes to School

Balfour Beatty is working in partnership with Southampton City Council to manage highway services across Southampton. We wrote to you recently regarding the upcoming St Monica Safer routes to school project. The adaptations in the area will include.

1. A new zebra crossing on South East Road at St Monica Road to create a safe crossing point to get to school, shops and the church. This includes changes to the footway and making a 'no entry' into St Monica Road from South East Road
2. A 20mph speed limit on several roads - with new speed cushions approaching to the crossing on South East Road
3. A School Street on St Monica Road and Maxwell Road that removes traffic at the beginning and end of the school day.
4. More dropped kerbs on St Monica Road and Kathleen Road to improve accessibility to the school and bus stop.
5. Making Chapel Crescent one-way from its junction with South East Road with priority changes to junctions with Rothbury Close and Cunningham Crescent
6. Road resurfacing on South East Road from the lay-by outside of the Co-op to near the junction with Kathleen Road. Resurfacing will also take place on sections of St Monica Road and at the Chapel Crescent/Rothbury Close junction.

There have been some slight variations to the programme of works that we would like to share with you. Please see the new schedule overleaf. We would like to confirm that the duration has not changed, it is the sequence that has.

We understand that these works will impact you, and should you need any help during the works our team on site will assist you wherever they can. Our team will ensure that refuse collections are unaffected. Should you have any large deliveries please let the team know so that they may facilitate this.
