

**THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON
(GLEN EYRE ROAD) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026**

Statement of Reasons

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising (*i.e. to improve safety*)
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

Following a review of the existing buildouts on Glen Eyre Road and community feedback, the Council is progressing with a scheme to make the following changes:

- The removal of the buildouts between Bassett Avenue and Violet Road, excluding the three buildouts around the Electric Vehicle Charging Bays which will be retained.
- Removal of the E-Scooter and Cycle Hire Bay which will be replaced with no waiting at any time restrictions.

These changes are intended to facilitate access and support safe passage along Glen Eyre Road.

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
